Water	Hydrated with water before the performance. Hydrate again afterwards. Avoid sugary drinks (juice, softdrinks, etc) and caffeinated drinks (tea, coffee, energy drinks, etc).
Breakfast + snacks	Make sure you've had something to eat in the morning. Pack a snack for later.
Shoes	Wear comfortable and secure footwear with a stable heel.
Seating	Will be limited and prioritized for those who require it. Be prepared to stand for up to 90 minutes if you are able to. If you require a seat or are planning to bring your own, please let Libby or Fred know.
UV protection	Follow SunSmart guidelines: use sunscreen, wear a hat, use sunglasses, seek shade, cover exposed skin with clothing. Sun protection is recommended between 8:40 AM - 5:20 PM.
Slips/trips/falls	Every effort will be made to remove trip hazards. Look out for: changes in walking surfaces (concrete to grass to decking) and elevation (stairs, cracks/lips in paving, curbs).
Fatigue	Take care as you exit the event of fatigue-related stumbles or errors. Consider if you need to stop and rest for a while before doing the next thing. Encourage other people to rest if they appear to be fatigued.

Manual handling	Be mindful of moving objects. Seek help for heavy or awkward objects. Use trolleys when possible. Use boxes or bags for loose objects to avoid drops or distraction when moving around.
Electrical	Only use equipment that has been tested and tagged.
Parking	Is expected to be difficult due to the Market. Allow time to park a little further away and walk to the site. Accessible parking is managed by the Market Organiser, and is not guaranteed. If mobility is difficult for you, please make plans for support. Contact Libby or Fred if you have any questions.
Security	There is no security provided for your personal belongings at this event.
Santa's appearance	A private area will be provided for Santa to dress. A helper will be assigned to assist Santa's movement, and monitor for little people moving around. Santa will join in the singing.
