(*softly*) He scares me **so**.

Middle 8 (loud) ^ Should I bring him down,

Should I scream and shout?

Should I speak of love,

What's it all— a-**bout?** (*hold for 6 beats*)

Verse 4 (softly) **Yet**— if he said he **lov-ed** me

^ I'd be lost, I'd be **fright-ened**
